## WHITE WINES

10. Van Zylshof Sauvignon Blanc Robertson (South Africa) 20.00  
*The Van Zyl's produce some of the very best value wines available. This example has flavours that lean towards grassiness and asparagus. A very well balanced and refreshing wine.*
11. Pinot Grigio Trentino (Italy) 21.00  
*Fresh crisp fruit with just a hint of smokiness. A very clean well defined flavour and refreshing dry finish.*
12. Van Zylshof Chenin Blanc (South Africa) 20.00  
*Bonnievale near Robertson, South Africa. Excellent value; soft enjoyable, refreshing, with Guava like flavours; well balanced with long after taste.*
13. Trapiche Oak Cask Chardonnay (Argentina) 21.00  
*Sourced from the foothills of The Andes Mountains, where the combination of altitude and generous sunshine produces concentrated, aromatic fruit. Aged in oak barrels, this Chardonnay shows pear, apple and pineapple aroma; a round wine with good acidity and lingering finish.*
14. Palacio de Leon Blanco, Castillo Y Leon (Spain) 18.00  
*From a remote region on a high plateau some 100 kilometres from the North East corner of Portugal & approximately the same distance West of Rioja. Clean and fresh, with a light fragrant bouquet of citrus fruit and pineapple.*
15. Van Zylshof Estate Chardonnay, Bonnievale, Robertson (South Africa) 20.00  
*Consistent quality has become a benchmark for this small vineyard's wines. This wine held the GOLD bench mark for four years in a row in SA's premier 'Veritas' competition. With a green-gold tint to the eye, followed by a full bodied citrus bouquet, we believe this to be a great addition to our Wine List.*
16. Nika Tiki Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc (New Zealand) 25.00  
*A powerfully aromatic wine with abundant fruit flavours. Made by, we are informed, the only Maori owned vineyard in the Country. We love this wine !*
17. Chablis Brocard (France) 27.00  
*A well balanced wine with lovely fruit and a mineral chalk and flint backbone.*
18. Chasselas Vieille Vignes Alsace (France) 31.00  
*Delicious herbal, grassy flavours, fruit driven, rounded yet intense flavours, produced from very old vines.*
19. Vavasour Sauvignon Blanc, Awatere Valley, Marlborough (New Zealand) 30.00  
*The bouquet is bursting with tropical fruits, melon and citrus. We really like this wine, with its smooth, clean finish, this is a real winner !*
20. Pouilly Fume Le Boisfleury, Loire (France) 36.00  
*Rich Sauvignon bouquet, crisp gooseberry and vibrant fruit on the palate, by Alain Cailbourdin, a top producer with fine reputation throughout the region.*

## WHITE WINES (continued)

21. **Domaine de Millet Colombard Ugni Blanc, Cotes de Gascogne (France)** 19.00  
*Produced by the Deche family, this is a light, fresh, mouth-watering wine with just the hint of aromatic elderflower fruit flavour, ideal we believe with a green curry.*
22. **A-Mano Fiano - Greco, Puglia (Italy)** 23.00  
*With just a hint of young tamarind through the nose, this wine from the Puglia region of Southern Italy, produces some of the best flavours from the Fiano and Greco di Tufo grapes. A wine with a rich golden colour, from extra time in contact with the skins of the grapes to extract all those lovely peach, apricot and honey flavours. The richness of this wine works exceptionally well with the heat of our dishes.*
23. **Viognier, Domaine de la Chapelle, Vin de Pays d'Oc (France)** 22.00  
*A light golden wine that is medium dry to the palate, with a slightly exotic perfume apparent to the nose, that gives the impression of a light sweetness. Smooth with a very pleasing aftertaste and delicate round soft fruit flavours, perfect with chicken & fresh ginger Kai Phad Khing.*
24. **Sauvignon Blanc Golden Age (Bulgaria)** 24.00  
*The enjoyment begins the moment your eyes settle on the stylish slim bottle. The grapes are picked at three different stages, judged on the development of the fruit aroma. As a result, the wine acquires a straw-yellow colour and a rich aroma of melon, grapefruit and peach. The fresh and round taste conveys a long-lasting soft finish.*

## RED WINES

30. **Merlot Stimson, Columbia Valley (California USA)** 21.00  
*A fabulous soft, plummy and jammy wine, laden with sultana and prune flavours, gently rounded off with a light spicy oak finish. Truly, one of our personal favourites !*
31. **Carmenere Bodegas Lauca, Maule River Valley (Chile)** 19.00  
*Intense colour anticipates the high concentration of aromas and flavours to follow. Well balanced tannins enhance the blackberry, cherry and red fruit aromas, with spices that leave you with a satisfying aftertaste.*
32. **Malbec Varietal, Bodegas Trapiche, Mendoza (Argentina)** 20.00  
*This grape has found it's ideal habitat in Mendoza. A rich-red colour, think almonds, plums, cherries with rounded flavour of truffles, intense blackberry fruit flavours and a long finish.*
33. **Teroldego Rotaliano Reserve (Italy)** 21.00  
*Located in the Campo Rotaliano area in the Trentino province, north eastern Italy. Intense ruby colour, with complex, characteristic aromas of ripe fruit, prunes and blackcurrant. This wine boasts a lovely smoky bouquet, with crisp, fruity flavours, mouth-watering with a nutty finish. A great partner with our Thai dishes.*
34. **Shiraz Broken Rock Estate, Coastal Region (South Africa)** 21.00  
*Deep colour followed by a full rich nose of dark fruits. On the palate, the wine displays round blackberry flavours with intense spicy notes; smooth and easy drinking, this wine has a good balance of freshness and a long lingering finish.*

## RED WINES (continued)

35. Finca Antigua Tempranillo, Crianza (Spain) 22.00  
*Sweet oaky nose, very forward red cherry fruit. Nicely integrated fruit and oak, obviously serious wine, but with very up front style.*
36. Broken Rock Pinotage, Coastal Region (South Africa) 21.00  
*This Pinotage exhibits a vibrant fruit character with delicate spicy notes, with cherry fruit and black plum flavours.*
37. Trapiche 'Oak Cask' Pinot Noir (Argentina) 25.00  
*From Bodegas Trapiche, Mendoza. Light raspberry/Frais du Bois flavours & Morello cherries, rounded to full soft fruit flavours through appropriate oak aging.*
38. Vacqueryas Domaine de Brunelly (France) 26.00  
*Mid Rhone. A full bodied wine, good colour & intense flavours. The vineyards are maintained to organic standards ideal with Tongdam's red meat dishes.*
39. Torbreck's Woodcutters Shiraz, Barossa (South Australia) 39.00  
*Ask for this wine to be 'splashed' into a jug to more easily release the mouth watering deep and lightly spiced flavours of this powerful wine. A great find from vines of 75 plus years old.*
40. Rioja Izadi Crianza (Spain) 26.00  
*This is what Rioja should be all about. Fresh, up front and ripe strawberry flavours from low yielding Tempranillo grapes with a touch of sweet spice from 12 months in oak. This delicious silky and spicy wine has enough weight and power to cope well with our hotter dishes.*
41. De Loach Zinfandel, Sonoma County (USA) 25.00  
*This winery is now owned by the French Burgundy house of Boisset, with more than a touch of that regions wine making style has gone into the making of this wine. Light in colour and in weight but with fantastic sweet, spicy ripe fruit and lovely meaty, sweet cherry and liquorice flavours that will compliment our spiced chicken and lamb dishes.*
42. Satrapezo Saperavi, Tellavi Wine Cellars, Telavi (Geogia) 37.00  
*A unique addition to our listing, Satrapezo, made from the Satrapezi grape, indigenous to the country. Produced in accordance with ancient wine making techniques dating back 6000 years. Fermentation takes place in Georgian clay reservoirs...Kveri... and buried for a time before being transferred into new oak for maturing. The end result is a round, smooth, full flavoured wine with black current and liquorice notes.*
43. Chianti Classico DOCG, Tenuta di Lilliano, Castellina, Tuscany (Italy) 33.00  
*A high percentage Sangiovese grape, with Colorino and Canaiola. Well matured in oak barrels, resulting in a wine with deep ruby colours. The perfume is intense, rounded and fruity.*
44. Albizu Tempranillo (Spain) 20.00  
*Made from the Tempranillo grapes that would have gone into making classified Rioja, this is a soft supple medium weight summer berry red wine that would go well with our lamb and duck dishes.*

## RED WINES (continued)

45. Masi Campofiorin Rosso del Veronese (Italy) 25.00  
*A rich, full bodied, round and velvety wine of Verona which combines simplicity and grace with power and majesty. A great label and a great wine in our eyes !*
46. Masi Costasera Amarone Classico (Italy) 46.00  
*The slopes facing the sunset are the best ones in Valpolicella Classica for producing high quality Amarone. This grape expresses a particular majesty and complexity, with a full rich flavour and another great label and excellent Italian wine in our view !*
47. Merlot Cab Mac Golden Age (Bulgaria) 24.00  
*The enjoyment begins the moment your eyes settle on the stylish slim bottle. The wine impacts with a delightful freshness and lively taste to the palate. This elegant wine has a powerful aroma of blackberry and strawberry, soft and well polished ripe tannins, with a long lasting smooth finish.*

## ROSE WINES

50. Santa Rita Rosé Cabernet Sauvignon (Chile) 19.00  
*This elegant dry rosé displays a full fruity bouquet reminiscent of strawberries & raspberries with a lively rich palate.*
51. Eikendal Stellenbosch Rosé (South Africa) 20.00  
*A deep beautiful rose pink colour and full of ripe berries flavour, this wine is just perfect for every occasion.*

## DESSERT WINES

58. Brown Brothers, Orange Muscat & Flora (Australia) (375ml) 15.00  
*This wine is blend of two grape varieties, Orange Muscat and Flora. Unique to Brown Brothers, it has flavours of citrus and stone fruit, with a fresh crisp finish.*

## SPARKLING WINES

60. Castillo Perelada Brut Rosado Cava (Spain) 22.00  
*Deep pink and in a clear bottle. Looks as it is, so appealing, refreshing, with soft red fruit flavours. This is an original rosé cava, made in the traditional method.*
61. Rotari Spumanti Mezzacorona (Italy) 24.00  
*Intense and fruity aromas, exhibiting a dry, well balanced and rich character on the palate, fine and persistent with a complex yet delicate finish.*
